Conditions

STRIKFORNATO is seeking highly motivated candidates from a wide variety of disciplines to the Internship Programme.

Applicants must meet the following prerequisites to apply:

- ⇒ Be a citizen of one of the 29 NATO member nations (NATO Partners and others will be considered on a case-by-case basis)
- ⇒ Be at least 21 years old
- ⇒ Be proficient in English, both written and oral
- ⇒ Be proficient in the use of Microsoft Office software

In order to be accepted you will need to have:

- ⇒ NATO SECRET Security Clearance
- ⇒ Health insurance

Internships last between 3 to 12 months, depending on the candidate's level of education and availability. Internships may commence at any point during the calendar year.
